Institutional Support Program Profile for the Local CSOs

"WE TOOK THE ROAD TOGETHER"

What is BİRLİKTE?

Working in the field of civil society with a strong and democratic civil society vision since 2004, STGM, has initiated "BİRLİKTE: Institutional Support Program for the Local CSOs, which is a grant and institutional support program aimed at strengthening the capacities of CSOs, after the need recognition studies by STGM with the CSOs. BİRLİKTE which was structured as a bi-directional and as an institutional grant and guidance support, differs from many of the grant programs in Turkey due to this specialty.



BİRLİKTE was primarily aimed at contributing to the development and strengthening of CSOs working at the local level. However, it also included national CSOs which aim to develop cooperation with the local communities. The program also envisions support for national CSOs whoich target to contribute to the civil society area by developing collaborations at the local level. According to the results announced in July 2018, in this Program;

CSOs are supported. 35 of these CSOs are supported under the local component and 7 of them under the national component. Sub-grant contracts with CSOs were signed in August and the first implementation year of the program started on August 16th.

How did the application process progress?

The announcement of the program's call for proposals was widely held. As of November 8, 2017, with the announcement, the Program attracted much attention. Since CSOs did not have to develop a new project at the time of application perido, this became an element that differed the Program from institutional grants of the other grant schemes. This is the main reason why the number of applications is so high.

The program was submitted to a total of **419 applications** from **53 cities.** In this process, 345 applications from the first component, that is from the local organizations, and 74 from the national organizations were submitted.



2018

JULY

On July 6, face-to-face interviews with the shortlisted organizations were completed.

On July 17, the results were delivered to the applicants who will benefit from the program.

2018

JANUARY

The application period was open for submissions for 2 months and the applications were accepted until the end of the working hours of the 8 January 2018.

APRIL

On April 20, the evaluation of the application documents was completed and a short list was prepared.

NOVEMBER

On November 8, 2017, BIRLİKTE Institutional Grant Program application announcement was published with the slogan of "Let's Change Together".

2017

MARCH

On 16 March, BiRLİKTE grant program has been started.

APRIL-OCTOBER

This process included a 7-month period between April and October 2017, with other additional elements such as program design, application guide, form and budget, sub-grant contract and report formats.

2016

NOVEMBER

The STGM team delivered the project document to the European Union Delegation in November 2016 after a very intensive preparation process.



Following the announcement of the program, promotion meetings were organized in Adana, Ankara, Diyarbakır, İstanbul, İzmir, Kars and Trabzon in December to promote the grant program and facilitate the application process.

A total of **387***people attended these meetings.

76 people attended the webinar for the same purpose. The CSOs that have adopted a rights-based approach in their works applied to the Program. According to the distribution of the applicant organizations in regards to their right fields, women, children, environment, human and disabled organizations were the fields that were encountered the most.

HOW THE EVALUATION OF THE APPLICATIONS WERE ASSESSED?

The evaluation process started on 15 January 2018 with the opening session where the administrative and compliance checks of the applications were completed. The opening session lasted about 2 weeks. A total of **375** applicants passed the eligibility check, and reached to the next stage and evaluated at the



internal and external evaluators worked in order to evaluate the applications.



Members of the Evaluation Committee participated in the process.

The applications were evaluated by at least

experts and approved by the evaluation committee members.

The evaluation process of the application documents started on 22nd of January and ended on the 2nd of April.





In the first stage of the application process,

the average of 3 application forms were read on a Daily basis. An application form was evaluated in an average of 3 hours and a form was graded by at least two people. Approximately 6 hours were spent on each application form. Forms with at least 20 points difference between the two evaluators were reevaluated by a third person. Up to 20 percent of the total application forms were read again and evaluated.


In the second phase of the process,

the shortlist was announced and the questions forwarded by e-mail were answered.

In the third phase,

face-to-face interviews were conducted with 75 CSOs shortlisted. During the two months, these meetings, which were held with the participation of an internal and an external expert, started on May 5th and ended on 6 July 2018.
